It is with deep regret that we have to record the death of Mrs. Ware, of How Foot, which took place, in London, after a long illness, on Sunday, June 4th. As the daughter of Bishop Harvey Goodwin and the wife of the Bishop of Barrow-in-Furness, she occupied a prominent place in the social life of the diocese and always fulfilled the duties devolving upon her with conspicuous ability. In every cause that had for its object the amelioration of the lot of the afflicted and the unfortunate she took a keen interest, and many Societies will miss her counsel and loyal support. Her death sadly accentuates the loss which the diocese suffered when Dr. Ware passed away. To the members of her family we desire respectfully to offer our sincere sympathy.

During the last four or five years Miss Helen Sumner, of Kelbarrow, has been engaged in making a copy of the oldest of the Grasmere Parish Registers. It must have been a laborious task to decipher so many pages of writing that the use of three centuries has rendered in many cases most difficult to read, but it has been prosecuted with that painstaking devotion which characterises all that she undertakes, and the care and skill with which the work has been done will win the admiration and gratitude of coming generations. The copy was finished at Easter and is now being bound.

It is hoped that an opportunity will be given the Parishioners of inspecting this interesting and beautiful volume. In the work of revision Miss Sumner has had the able assistance of Miss Armitt, of Rydal, whose antiquarian work is so well known.

The annual sermons will be preached and collections made on behalf of the Church Missionary Society, on Sunday, July 16th.
